Notes:

- The above fees are inclusive of stationery, lunches and also Personal Accident Insurance. Where a child is in receipt of a scholarship, bursary or other award, the discount will be applied excluding the cost of lunches and Insurance.
- On registering your child a registration fee of £100 is requested and a deposit of £500 is required a term before entry. Additional deposits are required for boarders from the EU - £2,500 and non UK or EU boarders will be required to pay a term's fee.
- Parents with more than one child in the school will qualify for a sibling discount of 5% for the second child and the third and subsequent children will receive a 10% discount.
- All tuition, boarding and transport fees are payable in full, on or before the first day of term. Full fees are payable during absence. Additional Insurances are offered, see Optional Charges below. We offer an in-house monthly instalment scheme and a fees in advance scheme. Details of both can be obtained from the School's Finance Office.
- Rechargeable extras include additional charges which will be made for exams, some school textbooks, Duke of Edinburgh/CCF participation, educational trips, instrumental lessons, learning support and some after school activities.
- Optional charges - Details of School Insurance Schemes are available from the Finance Office.

Notes:

- There is a minimum attendance of two days in Stages 1 - 3 and three days in Stage 4.
- Fees are inclusive of all milk, nappies, meals and snacks as appropriate.
- Specialist classes in art, music, dance, drama, sports, forest fun sessions and language teaching also included in the daily fee during term time as appropriate.
- Children aged 3 and 4 are entitled to access 15 hours of EYFE a week. Your child is eligible for this free entitlement from the start of the term following their third birthday until the end of the term of your child's fifth birthday. Reddam House offers EYFE for up to two sessions per day during Term Time only. The EYFE is shown without monetary value on termly fee invoices. Any additional services which the parents may opt for are charged in addition. Within Wokingham Borough there are a variety of EY providers offering the free entitlement. Some may offer the free entitlement only, without access to any additional services, other offer it over fewer hours of the week. Parents are encouraged to choose a service provider which best meets their needs.
- We are delighted to be able to offer two options for extended provision (30 hours) to all eligible families from September 2017
- Extended day provisions for children in Stage 5 incurs a charge of £5.20 per day for early drop off (8:00 – 8:30am) and for after school care up to 6pm a charge of £6.20. A termly fee of £490 applies for 8 - 6pm care five days a week.
- Childcare vouchers can be used for all fees for children below five years of age, and hours outside of the core day for children up to their 16th birthday.
- On registering your child a registration fee of £100 is requested and an additional deposit of £500 is required a term before entry into Stage 5.
