Welcome to our interim results newsletter focusing on the success of our A-level cohort. We will be following up after the publication of the GCSE results on the 23rd August with our full picture of achievements.

It has been a nail-biting wait for all our students and their families and the sense of anticipation as the envelope is handed over is always difficult.

It is of note that this year was exceptional in many ways, our best year for top results with an incredible 31% of our grades at A*/A and an increase in the average grade for the students rising a grade. We also significantly improved in every benchmark with the most notable being a rise in our A* to B grades by 8% to 55% this year; a wonderful achievement for this deserving cohort.



It goes without saying though that our focus on the day is always on the individual; we are so proud of all our students, many of whom achieved personal bests in the examinations.
